COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 338, L.D. 437, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase the Size of the Human Services Fraud
Investigation Unit."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and in-
serting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
of this Act.
