STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Labor Law in Relation to Items to be Furnished Employees by Railroad Corporations with Every Payment of Wages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA § 632 is enacted to read:

§ 632. Information to be furnished to railroad employees

Every railroad corporation in the State shall furnish each employee of that corporation with a statement with every payment of wages, listing accrued total earnings and taxes to date, and further furnish that employee at the same time with a separate listing of his daily wages and how they were computed.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of this section commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not more than \$100 may be adjudged for each offense.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that railroads furnish to their employees, with each payment of wages, a listing of that employees accrued earnings and taxes to date and also with a separate listing of his daily wages and how they were computed.
