HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 361, L.D. 470, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Participating Local Districts of the Maine State Retirement System to Discontinue Special Retirement Benefits Prospectively."

Amend the Bill in the title by inserting after the words "State Retirement System" the words 'and Union Representatives'

Further amend the Bill by inserting after the underlined words "local district" in the first line after the amending clause the underlined words 'and the union representatives'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit participating local districts and union representatives to discontinue special retirement benefits under Title 5, section 1092, subsection 3, prospectively to substitute for the discontinued benefit any other benefit provided for by the Maine State Retirement System.
