HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 365, L.D. 473, Bill, "AN ACT Regulating Business Practices

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the Bill in that part designated "§1903." by striking out all of subsections 2, 3 and 4.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow distributors and exhibitors to negotiate the terms under which the exhibitor will show a movie. Without this amendment, an exhibitor and a distributor will not be allowed to negotiate the terms of their agreement once bids have been policited.
