STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Concerning Expulsion of Disruptive Pupils from School.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 473, sub-§ 5, first sentence, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Expel any pupil who is repeatedly destructive or disorderly or insubordinate after a proper investigation of the pupil's behavior. The pupil shall be reinstated upon evidence of repentance and amendment to the satisfaction of the local educational agency responsible for the expulsion.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide local school units the means to correct repeatedly disruptive behavior in schools.
