COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 372, L.D. 478, Bill, "AN ACT  
Concerning Registration of Killed Deer."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting  
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §2355, sub-§3, ¶B, as repealed and replaced by PL  
1969, c. 425, §38, is repealed and the following enacted in its  
place:

B. If any person leaves the woods without taking a deer which  
he has killed with him, he shall notify a warden within 12 hours as  
to the location of the deer and the circumstances necessitating  
his leaving the same in the woods.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows hunters to notify wardens of deer taken  
if they cannot get to a registration station within 12 hours.
