COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "8" to H.P. 375, L.D. 485, Bill,
 "AN ACT for Per Diem Compensation for Active Retired Judges."

Amend the Bill in the 7th line of section 1 (6th and 7th lines of L.D.) by striking out the following underlined words and figures "rate of \$75 per day or \$40 per 1/2 day" and inserting in their place the following 'rate of \$50 per day or \$25 per 1/2 day'

Further amend the Bill in the 7th line of section 2 (5th line in L.D.) by striking out the following underlined words and figures "rate of \$75 per day or \$40 per 1/2 day" and inserting in their place the following 'rate of \$50 per day or \$25 per 1/2 day'

Further amend the Bill in the 6th line of section 4 (5th line in L.D.) by striking out the following underlined words and figures "rate of \$75 per day or \$40 per 1/2 day" and inserting in their place the following 'rate of \$50 per day or \$25 per 1/2 day'

Further amend the Bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
