SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 380, L.D. 487, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Assessments Upon Certain Public Utilities and to Authorize Use of the Funds Generated by Those Assessments to Pay Certain Expenses of the Public Utilities Commission."

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§17." by inserting after subsection 1, paragraph B, the following:

'2. Legislative approval of budget. The assessments and expenditures provided in this section shall be subject to legislative approval in the same manner as the budget of the Public Utilities Commission is approved.'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§17." by renumbering subsections 2 to 5 to be subsections 3 to 6.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require legislative review and approval of the expenditures and assessments of the Public Utilities Commission as provided by this legislation.
