STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Increase Atlantic Salmon Stamp Fees under the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2552, sub-§ 7, ¶ A, 2nd sentence, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 772, § 13, is further amended to read:

The fee for such stamp shall be \$1 \$2 for any resident of this State, 16 years of age or older, excluding Maine's Indian tribes who shall be exempt from the fee, 16 years of age or older, and \$15 \$20 for any nonresident, 16 years of age or older.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the fee for Atlantic Salmon stamps from \$1 to \$2 for residents of the State and from \$15 to \$20 for nonresidents.
