COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 391, L.D. 500, Bill,

Amend the Bill in the 11th line (9th line in L.D.) by  
striking out the underlined words "beaver sets" and inserting  
in their place the underlined words 'water sets and conibear  
traps, so-called'

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the requirement that water sets  
and conibear traps be visited every 72 hours in the unorganized  
territories.
