COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " H" to H.P. 421, L.D. 516, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Attorney's Fees when Expenses are Paid in Workers' Compensation Cases."

Amend the Bill by striking out in the 4th line of section 1 (3rd line in L.D.) the underlined words "<u>a client</u>" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'an employee'

Further amend the Bill by striking out in the 4th line of section 2 (3rd line in L.D.) the underlined words "<u>a client</u>" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'an employee'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make clear that it refers to lawyers who represent employees as opposed to employers.
