AN ACT to Prohibit Gill Netting in Spruce Creek, York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6572 is enacted to read:

§ 6572. Dragging in Spruce Creek

It is unlawful to fish by dragging or by using gill nets from the waters of Spruce Creek, a body of salt water located in the Town of Kittery, York County, north of the Kittery Point Bridge. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 17-A, section 4, whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the use of gill nets for fishing in the Spruce Creek, York County.
