COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " # to H.P. 411, L.D. 528, Bill, "AN ACT Authorizing the State to Contract with Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'The Department of Educational and Cultural Services is authorized to expend the money appropriated by the Legislature for the purchase of positions at accredited medical schools, up to the amount necessary to purchase up to 40 positions each year, to a total of 160, at the University of Vermont College of Medicine, Tufts University School of Medicine, Dartmouth Medical School or other accredited medical schools; up to 10 positions each year, to a total of 25, at Tufts School of Dental Medicine or other accredited dental schools; and up to 4 positions each year, to a total of 16, at the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine, the New York State College of Veterinary Medicine at Cornell University, Tufts University School of Medicine or other accredited schools of veterinary medicine; and up to 2 positions each year, to a total of 8, at the New England College of Optometry; and up to 10 positions each year, to a total of 40, at the New England College of Osteopathic Medicine.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to replace the phrase 'or other accredited schools of veterinary medicine' in the law. This phrase is already contained in the present law.
