HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.  
203, L.D. 535, Bill, "AN ACT to Eliminate the Dependency  
Disqualification for Persons Receiving Survivor's Bene-  
fits from the State Retirement System."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 4th  
paragraph of Section 10 and inserting in its place the  
following:

'Sec. 11. Allocation. The following funds shall be  
allocated from the General Highway Fund to carry out the  
purposes of this Act.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to state that funds  
from the General Highway Fund are "allocated" rather than  
"appropriated."
