COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 204, L.D. 536, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide that Unemployment Compensation be Based on the Minimum Wage for Certain Services Rather than on Tips and Gratuities Received for the Service."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Remuneration paid in the form of tips and gratuities shall be included only to the extent that the tips and gratuities are reported in writing to the employer.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include in the definition of "wages" only those tips and gratuities that are reported in writing to the employer.
