COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A to S.P. 206, L.D. 538, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent Cruelty to Animals by Establishing Certain Licensing Categories and Restrictions."

Amend the bill by striking out at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the following: "Sec. 1."

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the section which would require licensing sales or stud services of animals.
