# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

### AN ACT to Establish a Deadline for Removal of Ice Fishing Shacks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6523, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661,  $\S$  5, is amended by adding, after the first sentence, the following new sentence:

It shall be unlawful to place or to leave in place any shack or temporary structure used for ice fishing on the frozen coastal waters or to use the shack or structure from March 15th to June 15th, both days inclusive.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that all ice fishing shacks be removed from the frozen coastal waters by March 15th.
