SENATE AMENDMENT 'B' "to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT 'A' to H.P. 435, L.D. 552, Bill, "AN ACT to Require that all Public Employees be Paid at Least the Federal Minimum Wage."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 4th paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 4.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out at the beginning of the first line of the last paragraph before the fiscal note the following: "Sec. 6." and inserting in its place the following: 'Sec. 5.'
