COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 452, L.D. 566, Bill,
"AN ACT to Reinstate Mandatory Retirement for Certain Law
Enforcement Officers."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end of section 2,
before the period, the following:

';except that a state police officer appointed as the
Commissioner of Public Safety or the Chief of the State
Police shall not be required to retire at age 55'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows the Commissioner of Public Safety
and the Chief of the State Police to serve beyond age 55.
