HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 457, L.D. 570, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit Hunting of Bear with Dogs and to Prohibit Hunting Bear with Bait."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Prohibit Hunting Bear with Bait.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill by renumbering sections 2 and 3 to be sections 1 and 2.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end, before the statement of fact, the following:

'Sec. 3. Effective date. This bill shall become effective May 1, 1980.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the provision prohibiting hunting of bear with dogs and to add an effective date to the bill.
