## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

#### AN ACT to Prohibit Hunting of Bear with Dogs and to Prohibit Hunting Bear with Bait.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 2355-A, 3rd  $\P$ , as amended by PL 1975, c. 266, § 1, is further amended to read:

It shall be unlawful for any person to use a dog or dogs in conjunction with bear hunting during the period from May 1st to August 1st and during the regular firearms season on deer.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA § 2355-A, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 770, § 67, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

It shall be unlawful to place salt or any other bait or food in any place for the purpose of enticing bear thereto.

Sec. 3. 12 MRSA § 2355-D, as amended by PL 1975, c. 266, § 2, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits hunting of bear with dogs and prohibits the use of bait to entice bears.

It is inhumane for a human being carrying a firearm to use dogs to hunt bear and the practice should be prohibited. The use of bait causes unsightly and widespread litter; using bear bait is unnecessary and should be prohibited.
