COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 209, L.D. 582, Bill,
"AN ACT to Assist School Administrative Units in Addressing
Problems Associated with Alcohol, Tobacco and Drug Use and Abuse."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§1202." by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in
its place the following:

'4. Coordination of all state authorized school based
efforts. Assure coordination of all state authorized school
based efforts involving alcohol, tobacco and drug education,
prevention, intervention and referral for treatment programs; and'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that it is
only the school based efforts that are to be coordinated under
the bill.
