the Salary of that Post'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd
paragraph the following:


'Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §2, sub-§1, ¶E, sub-¶(3), relating to
HANCOCK COUNTY, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 657, §6, is
further amended to read:

(3) Sheriff ~~±27,000~~ \$13,300'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the beginning
of the first line of the 3rd paragraph the following: 'Sec. 2.'

The purpose of this amendment is to raise the annual
salary of the Hancock County/^{sheriff} to bring it into conformity
with salaries of other similar positions.
