AN ACT to Define the Post of Hancock County Sheriff as Full Time.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 910 is enacted to read:

§ 910. Hancock sheriff to be full time

The office of sheriff of Hancock County shall devote his entire time to the duties of his office.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clarifies the fact that the office of sheriff of Hancock County is a full-time job.
