COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 475, L.D. 592, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Appropriate Funds to Provide for Lobster Rearing  
Stations."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation; lobster rearing stations. The following  
funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out  
the purposes of this Act.
