Amend the amendment in the 7th line by
striking out the underlined words "a new criminal offense" and
inserting in their place the underlined words 'murder or a Class
A, B or C crime, which murder or crime is other than the one for
which he was placed on probation'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the authority of
a prosecutor under the bill to the more serious crimes rather than
having it apply to any new criminal offense.
