COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 482, L.D. 613, Bill,
"AN ACT to Eliminate the Jurisdiction of the Maine Milk
Commission over 1/2 Pint Containers of Milk."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

- '7 MRSA \$2954, sub-\$3, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 517, \$2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 3. Exemptions for on-premise sales of raw milk and for administrative units.
  sales to school / The minimum price provisions of this chapter shall not apply to sales by producers of raw milk produced and sold to consumers on the premises of the producers or to sales of milk to school administrative units.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment will exempt local school administrative units from the minimum price provisions of the Maine Milk Commission law.
