AN ACT to Provide for a Junior Archery License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2502, sub-§ 4 is enacted to read:

4. Resident junior archery license

12-16 years of age

1.50

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to create a resident junior archery license on the same basis as resident junior hunting licenses.
