**AN ACT to Require Lobstermen to Use Only One Buoy Color Combination.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**12 MRSA § 6421, sub-§ 6**, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, § 5, is amended to read:

**6. Buoy colors.** Each applicant shall describe, on the application ~~the~~ **a single, unique** color design of his buoys.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that a lobster fisherman only use one color combination and design on all of his lobster buoys.
