COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 497, L.D. 634, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate the Hunting of Bear."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §2355-C, as amended by PL 1975, c. 516, §11, is repealed.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering section 2 to be section 3.

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 1980.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment repeals a section of the statutes that the bill makes obsolete and delays the effective date of the Act until January 1, 1980.
