**RESOLVE, to Provide a Minimum Retirement Credit to Shirley Quint of
Hodgdon.**

Shirley Quint; state retirement benefits authorized. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Maine State Retirement System is directed to provide Shirley Quint of Hodgdon with a pension of \$100 per month for the remainder of her lifetime, unless she becomes the dependent of another person, at which time benefits shall cease.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve will provide Shirley Quint of Hodgdon with a pension of \$100 per month for the rest of her life or until she becomes the dependent of another person.
