**AN ACT to Authorize Constables to Use Blue Lights on Their Vehicles.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**29 MRSA § 1368, sub-§ 2**, as amended by PL 1973, c. 31, is further amended to read:

**2. Police department vehicles.** Lights used on police department vehicles and on motor vehicles operated by chiefs of police, state fire inspectors, inland fisheries and game wardens, sea and shore fisheries wardens, Baxter State Park rangers, **constables**, sheriffs and deputy sheriffs shall emit a blue beam of light.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes the use of blue lights on motor vehicles operated by constables.
