COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 543, L.D. 674, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit an Intentional Attempt to Elude a Police Officer through High-speed Driving."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Whoever, after being requested or signaled to stop, attempts to elude the officer by driving a vehicle at a reckless rate of speed which results in a high-speed chase between the operator's vehicle and any law enforcement vehicle using a blue light or siren shall be guilty of a Class D crime.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the language of the bill and lower the penalty from Class C to Class D.
