SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 587, L.D. 734, Bill, "AN ACT Making Adjustments in the Basic Need Standards and Payment Maximums of the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the appropriation and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation; aid to families with dependent children.
The percentage of needs payment shall be increased from 95% of 1969 standard of need to 68% of 1973 standard of need effective October 1, 1979 and the following amounts are appropriated therefor:
