SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 624, L.D. 766, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Conspicuous Posting of Retail Gasoline and Diesel Fuel Prices."


Amend the Bill in subsection 1 by striking out all of the last 2 underlined sentences.

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Fuel for use by vehicles on public highways. Subject to the provisions of Title 23, chapter 21, a retail seller of internal combustion engine fuel to be used by vehicles on public highways shall post the current price charged for each fuel grade in a manner that is clearly visible to the traveling public.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the bill less restrictive and to allow for more flexibility in implementing its provisions.
