SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 636,
L.D. 787, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Dollar Amount of an
Accident that Must be Reported from \$200 to \$500."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the
3rd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §891, first ¶, is amended to read:

The Chief of the State Police shall prepare and shall supply
to police and sheriffs' offices and other suitable agencies forms
of accident reports calling for sufficiently detailed information
to disclose, with reference/^{to} ~~a highway-accident~~ an accident on a
public way or any place where public traffic may reasonably be
anticipated the cause, conditions then existing and the persons
and vehicles involved.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §891, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1973, c. 689,
§2, is further amended to read:

The Chief of the State Police shall receive accident reports
required by law and shall tabulate and analyze such reports and
may publish annually, or at more frequent intervals, statistical
information based thereon as to the number, cause and location of
~~highway-accidents~~ an accident on a public way or any place where
public traffic may reasonably be anticipated.

Sec. 3. 29 MRSA §891, 6th ¶, first sentence, as amended by PL 1973, c. 689, §4, is further amended to read:

The driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person or property damage to the apparent amount of ~~§200~~ §300 or more, or some person acting for him, shall, within 48 hours after the accident, make a written report of it to the Secretary of State, on forms provided by said Secretary of State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that information be furnished on accidents on public ways or any places where public traffic may reasonably be anticipated rather than merely on highways
