STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Allow the Temporary Placement of Real Estate Signs under the Maine Traveler Information Services Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 23 MRSA § 1913, sub-§ 15 is enacted to read:
- 15. Real estate signs. Signs no larger than 4×4 feet located upon a premises with the permission of the owner advertising those premises for sale, for the period of a valid listing contract or until those premises are sold, whichever is earlier.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would exempt temporary real estate signs no larger than 4 x 4 feet from the provisions of the Maine Traveler Information Services statutes.
