HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 672, L.D. 833, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating to Games of Chance."

Amen the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of
subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Schemes prohibited. No license shall be issued
after December 31, 1980 for the conduct or operation of any
machine, slot machine or roulette, or for the operation of
any games commonly known as policy or numbers.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the
prohibition of licensing of slot machines to all gambling
machines whether they be operated by the insertion of
coins or by remote control devices after December 31, 1980.
