RESOLVE, to Provide Minimum Retirement Credit for Elwood Lloyd of Smyrna.

Elwood Lloyd; state retirement benefits authorized. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Maine State Retirement System is directed to provide Elwood Lloyd of Smyrna with a pension of \$100 per month for the remainder of his lifetime, unless he becomes the dependent of another person, at which time benefits shall cease.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve will provide Elwood Lloyd of Smyrna with a pension of \$100 per month for the rest of his life or until he becomes the dependent of another person.
