COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 293, L.D. 854, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Consistent Hours of Operation by State Retail and Agency Liquor Stores."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§154." and inserting in its place the following:

'§154. Business hours

State retail liquor stores and state agency stores may be open for the sale and delivery of liquor in municipalities and unincorporated places which have voted affirmatively on section 101, subsection 1. Their hours may be as follows: If a state retail store, between 9 a.m. and midnight; if a state agency store, between 6 a.m. and midnight.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow state agency stores to sell liquor at 6 a.m. rather than 9 a.m., as it currently allows.
