COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 690, L. D. 862, Bill,  
"AN ACT Concerning the Maine Property Insurance Cancellation  
Control Act."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting  
in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA §3049, next to last ¶, first sentence,  
as enacted by PL 1973, c. 239, is repealed and the following  
enacted in its place:

This section shall not apply to any policy or coverage which  
has been in effect less than 60 days at the time notice  
of cancellation is received by the named insured, or 90  
days in the case of residential property other than the insured's  
primary residence which is expected to be continuously  
unoccupied for 3 months in any 12-month period, unless it is  
a renewal policy.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 3.

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes section 3 of the bill concerning the  
insured's failure to correct a specifically identified hazard  
and extends to 90 days the period within which the insurer  
may underwrite and inspect seasonal property without becoming  
Maine Property Insurance  
subject to the/Cancellation Control Act.
