HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 692,
L.D. 870, Bill, "AN ACT Amending the Law Relating to Elevators
and Tramways."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first paragraph
the following:

'Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §159-A, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1979,
c. 253, §2, is amended to read:

B. "Recreational or harvesting activities" shall
mean recreational activities conducted out of doors,
including hunting, fishing, trapping, camping, hiking,
sight-seeing, operation of snow-traveling vehicles,
skiing, hang-gliding, boating, sailing, canoeing,
rafting or swimming or activities that involve harvesting
or gathering forest products. It shall include entry,
use of and passage over premises in order to pursue
these activities.

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment limits the liability of property owners
who allow hang-gliding on their land and do not receive compen-
sation in return for that permission.
