**AN ACT to Prevent Game Wardens from Trapping in the Area in Which They  
Work.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**12 MRSA § 2005** is enacted to read:

**§ 2005. Wardens prohibited from trapping**

**No inland fish and game warden shall trap in the warden district to which he is assigned or in any warden district adjacent thereto.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent trapping by fish and game wardens in the areas in which they work.
