HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 713, L.D. 886, Bill, "AN ACT to Designate the Moose as the State Animal."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Designate the Moose as the State Animal and to Repeal the Experimental Open Season on Moose.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §215 is enacted to read:

§215. State animal

The state animal shall be the moose.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §2355-F, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 56, is repealed.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to repeal the experimental hunting season on moose, in order to preserve the animal which is designated as the state animal under the provisions of the bill
