AN ACT to Designate the Moose as the State Animal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1 MRSA § 215 is enacted to read:

§ 215. State animal

The state animal shall be the moose.

The purpose of this bill is to designate the moose as the state animal.
