AN ACT to Repeal the Agent Requirement for the Issuance of Certain Semitrailer Permits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 245-A, ¶ 3, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 163, and as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 481, § 8, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Under the present motor vehicle statutes, foreign domiciled carriers who wish semipermanent semitrailer plates must appoint a resident agent to sign registration certificates and to take service of process.

This requirement is unnecessary and costly and should be repealed.

This bill repeals the requirement.
