COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 303, L.D. 893, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Reimbursement Rate to Residential Child Care Facilities."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause inserting in its flace the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3802, sub-§1, ¶B, as amended by

PL 1977, c. 107, is further amended to read:

B. For residential child care facilities in an amount equal to—but—not—exceeding—86% 90% of audited unit cost and based on actual expenditures in the most recent fiscal year. The total amount paid from—all—sources by the State shall not exceed ±00%—90% of actual cost for the care of state wards.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the state reimbursement to residential child care facilities from 80% to 90% of the costs incurred for care of wards of the State.

Moreover, the facilities should not be prohibited from program development and physical expansion when needed.
