SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 310, L.D. 901, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit Taking Antlerless Deer in Certain Municipalities and Townships."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Provide a Temporary Season on Antlerless Deer in Certain Municipalities and Townships.'

Further Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2353-C." by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'The commissioner may establish a temporary season in the following areas and shall by rule and regulation provide a lawful means for a person to take one wild deer with antlers not less than 3 inches long.'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a temporary season on antlerless deer in certain municipalities and townships.
