COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 732, L.D. 919, Bill,
"AN ACT to Update the Insured Value Factor in the Computation of
Legal Tuition Fees under the Education Statues."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'This amount shall be defined as the insured value factor and
it shall not exceed ~~\$75-per-pupil-in-any-one-year~~ 7.5% of a
school's legal tuition rate per pupil in 1979-80 and 9% of a school's
legal tuition rate per pupil in any given year starting in 1980-81.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish a new
formula for the maximum amount which may be computed as the
insured value factor.
