STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Repeal the Portable Stove Exemption to the Statutes Governing Kindling of Out-of-door Fires.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 1401, last paragraph, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 607, § 2, is repealed.
- Sec. 2. 12 MRSA § 1402, 2nd paragraph, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 179, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the portable stove exemption to the statutes governing kindling of out-of-door fires.
